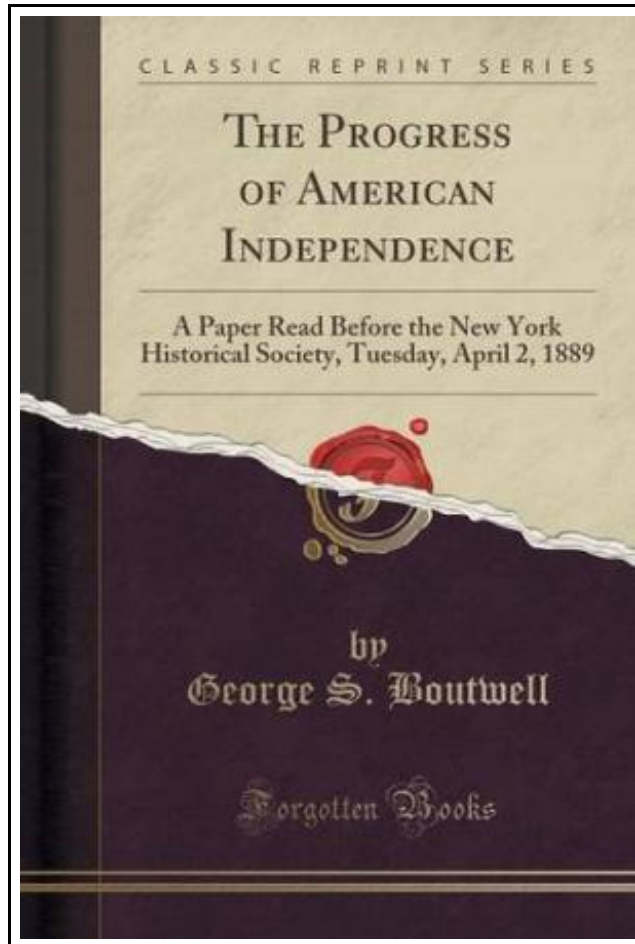

It has, however, occurred to me that to those of us who participated in or were witnesses of the bloody contest through which the nation passed in the years 1861-2-3-4 and 5, an hour might be spent profitably in an examination into the nature of a struggle with which our own experience is intimately connected.
