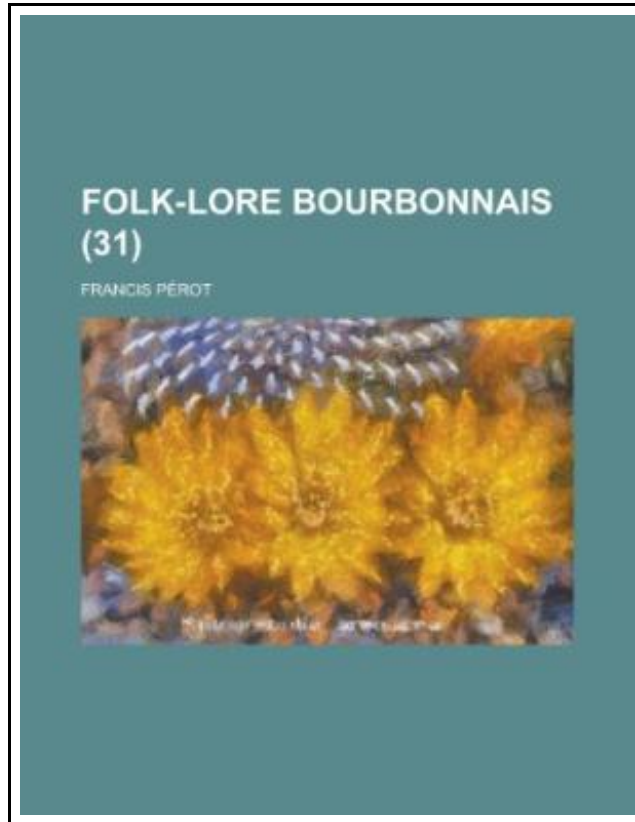

Local populations of eastern cottontails may reach a density of 20 ( 8 acre ) rabbitslha although densities are normally lower ( Chapman et al. 1982 ). The average winter home range size for male and female eastern cotton-tails in Tennessee was 2. 8 ha ( 6. 9 acres ) and 2. 2 ha ( 5. 4 acres ), respectively ( Anderson and Pelton 1976 ). Male cottontails in Wisconsin had an average spring home range size of 2. 8 ha ( 6. 9 acres ), and an average early summer home range of 4. 0 ha ( 9. 8 acres ) ( Trent and Rongstad 1974 ).
