

Kelly Pender tells the story of techne s presence in the development of rhetoric and composition as an academic discipline in the mid-twentieth century, the influence of postmodern theory on that development, and what is often taught or not taught under the rubric of writing in contemporary composition courses. The arguments TECHNE, FROM NEOCLASSICISM TO POSTMODERNISM makes about these relationships are deconstructive and seek to challenge some of the field s most firmly entrenched binaries about what writing is and how (or if) it should be taught. To make these arguments, TECHNE, FROM NEOCLASSICISM TO POSTMODERNISM uses Samuel Weber s retranslation of the Heideggerian term Ge-stell as a form of emplacement to show how composition theories and pedagogies based on techne work simultaneously to both close down and open up possibilities for experiencing writing as an inherently valuable, nonrational mode of bringing-forth.
